#### **Highlights for previous year**

- Feedback on new levels gathered at February Rules Revision session and fed into programme prior to start of 2018 competition programme.
- Bedding in of new levels and new competition programme during second year of running.
- Offer of judging clinics at Zone competitions to allow judges from different Zone to shadow and learn.
- Both Southern Zone and Southern Grading competitions ran ahead of time. Northern Grading to be held in May and Northern Zone in June, both at Redbridge.
- Introduction of pennants for club winners to keep proved popular.
- Overall feedback from clubs and parents about the system has been positive and will help to develop the programme further.

#### Concerns

- Clubs are still failing to provide judges or judges pull out at last minute.
- Some clubs not following rules at grading event around handing gymnasts to parents to allow them to go to medal table as a family.
- Judging quality on occasions still a concern, however, oversight of experienced Head Floor and Vault judges has helped to standardise panels and to improve skills of regular core group of judges.

#### **Looking Forwards:**

- Work begun to create a more spectacular London GfA Final at Redbridge in November 2018.
- Next rules revision day to be held before end of 2018 to allow time to make changes ahead of 2019 programme.
- Build on feedback to develop levels and 2019 programme, including lowering L3 floor pin mark, introducing bonuses for L4-6 and reviewing vaults.
- As we can't run competitions without judges, 2019 will see the introduction of 'no judge, no competition' rule, as allowed by LG.
- Continue to develop judges through up-skilling opportunities.
- Review number of judges provided by larger clubs.
- Introduction of new rules for grading events to ensure clubs allow parents to join gymnast to pick up medal.
