Eligibility:	If a gymnast is not eligible to compete in the Junior British Championship she may enter the Junior Challenge Cup. If a gymnast has failed Compulsory 2 she may enter the Challenge Cup. If a gymnast has previously participated in the British Championships or passed Compulsory 2, a written application must be submitted to the WTC requesting dispensation to withdraw from the elite path.
Age Groups:	Junior 14 / 15 in the year of competition
Competition Requirements:	FIG competition I
Competition Format:	FIG
Coaches:	One coach (from two nominated) on the competition floor at any one time. It is the responsibility of the club entering a gymnast to ensure that the coach in attendance at the competition (minimum WA Level 2) has undergone appropriate training for the skills being competed by their gymnast.
Apparatus Specifications:	FIG specifications
Promotion:	A gymnast who attains the qualifying score (46.00 or more) at this competition will be eligible for the 2013 British Championships.
Re-qualification:	Any gymnast who enters the Challenge Cup attempting to re-qualify for the 2013 British Championships will not be eligible for awards at this competition. Second year Espoirs attempting to re-qualify for the British Championships may participate at the Junior Challenge Cup in order to achieve the qualifying score 44 or more. Espoir gymnasts will be judged on current FIG Junior Code.
