Eligibility:	<p>Levels 4 & 3 - Regions must identify the Voluntary Level 4 & 3 competition, which will count towards selection for the National Finals. The first four gymnasts in Levels 4 and 3 will represent the region in the National Finals. Gymnasts who do not finish in first four in their region are eligible to enter National Finals as individuals as long as they have achieved the required score (44.00 at Level 4 & 46.00 at Level 3) in the regional voluntary levels qualifier and have a carry forward score from the 2012 National Compulsory Finals. Evidence of qualifying scores must be sent to the Competition Organiser by post or email by closing date.</p> <p>Level 2 - Individual entry direct to National. No regional qualification required. Entrants must have passed Level 3 Compulsory. Evidence of qualifying scores must be sent to the Competition Organiser by post or email by closing date. <i>NB Level 2 is not a team competition</i></p>

Team:	<p>For Level 4 and Level 3 the team score will be the 3 best scores on Vault, Bars, Beam, & Floor. The nominated reserve may replace a withdrawn team member before the start of the competition. If the reserve was entered as an individual but competes in the team no refund of individual entry fee will be made. Working order for the team must be handed in at registration. NB Changes to working order on a piece of apparatus can be made BEFORE the 2 minute warm-up on that apparatus by informing the competition organiser/arena administrator. Individuals will be drawn at the end of groups and if there is more than one of them they will rotate.</p>		
Coaches:	<p>Maximum one coach per gymnast. In addition each region must nominate a Team Manager who will be responsible for the general conduct of the team as well as registration and any protests. It is the responsibility of the region/club entering a gymnast to ensure that the coach in attendance at the competition (minimum WA Level 2) has undergone appropriate training for the skills being competed by their gymnast.</p>
