Eligibility:	<p>Must have passed Compulsory 3 – minimum score 50.00 including a minimum of 10.00 on R & C. Evidence of qualifying scores must be sent to the Competition Organiser by post or email by closing date. 2nd annual attempt is for 'in age' (11 years) only. No regional qualification required – entry direct to National</p>
Age Groups:	11 years old in year of competition
Competition Requirements:	Refer to WTC Competition Structure Booklet (update August 2010)
Competition Format:	FIG
Coaches:	<p>One coach (from two nominated) on the competition floor at any one time. It is the responsibility of the club entering a gymnast to ensure that the coach in attendance at the competition (minimum WA Level 2) has undergone appropriate training for the skills being competed by their gymnast.</p>
Apparatus Specifications:	<p>FIG specifications except: <u>VAULT</u> 2 x 60cm blocks Springboards soft and hard turbo boards + soft coil board will be supplied Yurchenko block + hand mat <u>BARS</u> Single High Bar - 30cm safety matting with a covering mat on top of FIG spec landing mats</p>
Pass Mark:	<p>To progress to Espoir British Championships a pass mark (minimum 52.50 including a minimum score of 10.50 on Range and Conditioning) is required. Once a gymnast has passed Compulsory Level 2, she may not revert to the Club Grades system. A gymnast may revert to the Club Grade system if she fails.</p>
Re-take of R & C:	<p>Any gymnast who achieves an overall pass mark of 52.50 but fails R & C (having achieved 9.00 or above) will be given a single re-take opportunity following the end of the Compulsory Level 2 competition at the venue. This will be the only re-take opportunity. Coaches should declare intention to re-take to the event organiser by the end of the competition. The WTC will appoint the Judging Panel.</p>
Awards:	All gymnasts passing Compulsory 2 will be awarded certificates
