# **Warm Up Times:**

Please see below general and apparatus warm up times.

All rounds operate a warm-up and compete scenario following the general warm-up and march in.

**In the first round and rotation of each day** gymnasts will move directly from general warm up (in the arena) to the their first piece ready to start their timed apparatus warm-up before starting their competition.

Gymnasts are **not required to line up in front of judges** after rotation 1 of each round.

Times may be adjusted on the day to reflect withdrawals.

**Horizontal Bar**: For gloves and loops, please ensure that your gymnasts put both hands in their loops. A simple nod will do to present to the judge.

**Vault Warm Up:** Each gymnast will receive 2 vaults practices for their warm-up. Due to the number of set ups, it is possible the order of warm-up and compete may change according to levels.

Warm-up times must be adhered to – please follow instructions of our floor marshals

# **Competition information**

**General Rules** 

All entry fees are non-returnable

Please check through the start list of names, check that gymnasts have been entered in the correct level and that the spelling of their name is correct.

Please ensure that your gymnasts arrive at least 30 minutes before the stated registration time, except for the first round of each dday.

**APP & PPP Routines** 

Due to the size of entries, there will be no APP or PPP exercises performed this year.

Gymnast free t-shirts

Each competing gymnast is entitled to a free event t-shirt which can be collected from our merchandise partner 'Elite Printwear'. A voucher will be issues at registration. It is possible to upgrade the t-shirt with additional styles.

Gymnast registration:

Registration of gymnasts will take place in the main arena between two blocks of bleacher seating. Coach, parent or gymnast may register via online screens. Photographs will also be taken at this point (for display on the arena screens).

Please ensure you inform us of any withdrawals at registration (or to the Competition Director if known prior to the event).

With the exception of round one of each day, all other registration periods are open (e.g. you can register upon arrival). Please ensure you register by the closing time which may be brought forward by 30 mins if the competition runs ahead of schedule.

## **Ceremony protocol**

Gymnasts will be presented their medals and stand behind the

winners rostrum for each presentation. Due to time constraints we will not stop for photos, and instead a separate photo area will be held nearest the parallel bars area. Photo Opportunity (our official photographers) and parents will be welcomed to take photos of the medal winning gymnasts immediately following the competition. Parents should enter the arena from the ground floor, entering the first door on the right of the corridor.

March Around:

Please ensure the gymnasts quickly line up behind their marshal when instructed. The gymnasts need to follow their marshal to get to their next piece. Please ensure all coaches remain back behind the lines until ALL the gymnasts have marched to the judges on their panel.

Gymnast repatriation:

At the end of each competition please listen to announcements as to how parents/guardians can safely collect their child.

Inquiries and protests

No formal inquiries are accepted.

Tie breaks:

In the event of a tied score, there will be no tie-break and tied gymnasts will have the same ranking.

Scoring and results:

Scores will be shown after each performance on the television screens in the arena. A printed receipt with the score will be handed to coaches. Finalised score sheets will be sent to competing clubs. #### **Directions:**



**From the M11:** At the end of the M11, take the left hand fork towards The City and A12. Take the first exit and at the roundabout at the end of the slip road take the first exit onto Redbridge Lane East. Go across several mini roundabouts and, when coming to a large one, go straight over into Longwood Gardens. Continue along Longwood Gardens (over some more mini roundabouts!) until you get to another slightly larger one. Turn right at this roundabout into Fremantle Road.

At the traffic lights, turn left into Barkingside High Street. Carry on down until you reach the main roundabout. Take the third exit into Forest Road. The Centre is about 100 yards up on the left hand side just before the railway bridge.

**From the North Circular Eastbound:** Take the A1400 exit off the North Circular (just before the M11). At the roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit towards Southend and the A127. Go over a set of pedestrian lights and at the next set of lights take the left hand turn into Clayhall Avenue. Go straight up Clayhall and at the roundabout go straight over (effectively the first exit.) At the traffic lights turn left into Barkingside High Street. At the next roundabout take the third exit into ForestRoad.



Ample FREE parking is available.



On arrival at the Centre follow the road below PAST the first sports centre (red van pictured in photograph). The competition venue is the silver building top left. The Jean Brown Arena competition venue is pictured RIGHT. Please enter through the glass doors at the front and follow directions. London event staff (turquoise polo shirts) will be able to direct you.

**Exceptions:** Gymnasts & Coaches must purchase a ticket to watch any competition days in which they are not competing. Where a competition level runs across two rounds, gymnasts and coaches may sit in the spectator seating for free on the session in which they are not competing.

Wristbands will be issued instead of tickets. If you are issued with a ticket prior to the event, please exchange this for a wrist band upon arrival. These should be worn at all times to help our stewards easily identify that you have paid.

**Gymnasts:** 

Must have current BG Bronze membership for Regional Competitions and Silver Competitive membership for National Competitions.

Judges:

Judges require a current minimum Bronze BG membership & relevant judging qualification

**Anti-Doping** 

London Gymnastics follows the BG anti-doping statement.

"The anti-doping rules of British Gymnastics are the UK Anti-Doping Rules published by the Drug Free Sport Directorate of UK Sport (or its successor), as amended from time to time. Such rules shall take effect and be construed as rules of British Gymnastics."

BG/LG Photo Policy:

By entering an LG event, there is an acceptance that the participants may be photographed and the photograph may be published in LG communications. Any person wishing to use video, film, or take photographs must abide by the BG 'Photography at Events' Policy. <a href="http://bit.ly/BGPhotopolicy">http://bit.ly/BGPhotopolicy</a>

Photos may only be taken for personal use. You may not take photos for sale, other commercial use, or publications in printed or electronic form, such as on websites. Clubs may publish some photos of their own gymnasts, but this may only be done in accordance with BG 'Child Protection' Policy

Flash may not be used at any time whilst gymnasts are warming up or competing. Any concerns about any photographer or the suitability of any photos being taken should be reported to the Welfare Officer at the event.

Nominated coaches must not take photos or videos, whilst in the arena, with the exception of during presentations. Coaches who are spectators are covered by the same rulings as parents/guardians.

Gymnast's attire:

Gymnasts must march on in competition attire/ club tracksuits.

Jewellery, body piercing and similar adornments are not allowed

Coach's attire: In line with BG regulations, coaches must wear club tracksuit or polo

shirt, t -shirt and long track bottoms. Footwear should be clean trainers or socks. Coaches will not be allowed on the floor if wearing

inappropriate clothing or jewellery.

Chewing gum is not permitted at any time.

Judges attire: Judges and officials must wear black/blue suits, skirts or trousers

with jackets and white shirts with black smart shoes.

Competition Etiquette: Please ensure that gymnasts and coaches use the seating provided

whilst waiting to perform on the apparatus. Please keep all you belongings together and only march to the next piece of apparatus

when instructed, ensuring that gymnasts march around the

apparatus and not across it.

Electronic communications: Apart from as required for the running of the competition, gymnasts,

coaches, judges and officials must not use mobile phones or any other electronic communication devices including tablets, to make calls, take photographs or be used for other forms of communication

in the arena during the event.
