	ROUTINES LIMIT	A maximum of 320 routines can be entered for this competition and first come-first served approach will be applied. Each club can enter maximum 40 routines. Once entry is submitted, clubs who would like to perform more than 40 routines can create a waiting list in GYMNET via request to londonrgchair@gmail.com . If spaces become are available, for routines on the waiting list, the clubs will be invited to submit their entry between 4 th -6 th April.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

N[®] CS MEMBERSHIP

- All clubs must be affiliates of London Gymnastics and registered with British Gymnastics.
- All gymnasts must hold current BG membership to the stated level and be a member of an LG affiliated BG club.
- All coaches must hold current and correct levels of BG membership and qualifications.
- All judges must hold current BG membership and current judging qualification. Clubs must provide a qualified judge or need to pay £50 levy without exception at the time of entry.

PHOTOGRAPHY

By entering an LG event, there is an acceptance that the participant may be photographed and the photograph may be published by LG. Photos and videos may only be taken and used in accordance with the BG Child Protection Policy. Where the Competition Organiser believes that a person taking or assisting in the taking of photos/videos is in breach of these conditions he or she may require that person to leave the venue. Photos may not be used, distributed or copied for commercial purposes. Flash may not be used at any time while gymnasts are warming up or competing.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

AWARDS ALLOCATION

- Gymnasts can perform a minimum of 1 and maximum of 3 routines depending on their level and age category¹
- There will be a medal ceremony for each individual apparatus per age category and level. All gymnasts will receive awards:
 - 1st 3rd place: Gold/Silver/Bronze Medal and personalised certificate
 - 4th 6th place: LG medal and personalised certificate
 - 7th 8th place: personalised certificate
 - 8th place and after: participation certificate

LEVELS

SILVER BG
MEMBERSHIP

• Level 5: Elite = Qualifier for British Championships Elite Group League/British Championships

- **Level 4: National** = Qualifier for NDP Finals National Group League/NDP Finals
- Level 3: Zonal/Regional = Took Grades but did not qualify for NDP Finals or is working at a standard suitable for the CoP

Basic Code will be used for all gymnasts in Level 0, 1 & 2. Gymnasts in Level 0 and 1 should not perform body difficulties with higher value than 0.3 (COP). Difficulties above value of 0.3 (COP) for Level 0 and 1 will not be valid.

- Level 2: Club = Competition 6 onwards and level of gymnast suitable for Basic Code rather than CoP
- Level 1: Club = First 5 competitions only
- Level 0: Recreation = Training 2-4 hours per week

REGIONAL RANKING

REGIONAL RANKING

- **Participation points**: 10 points per routine will be allocated to each club/gymnast for participation in the London Rhythmic Gymnastics Championships 2018¹
- Individual Ranking Points: gymnasts will receive extra points if they rank 1st -8th place (Table 2).

YEAR END

- On 9th December 2018 all points will be aggregated to determine the regional ranking of clubs and gymnasts.
- These results will be used to determine future allocation of funding and benefits for clubs and gymnasts²

Note: 10 points will be given to all clubs for each routine they enter in the competition Note: Special rules will be applied for categories with only one participating gymnast in Level 4 & 5 (the gymnast should score higher than the first gymnast in the lower level to get the allocated points. If the score is lower, points allocation will be benchmarked against the lower level.
