Highlights from previous year

- Replaced older equipment in north and increased equipment in south to ensure opportunities to grow GfA in future.
- Number of entries for all competitions increased.
- Both Southern Zone and Southern Grading competitions ran ahead of time. Northern Grading and Northern Zone to be held in June, both at Redbridge, and GfA Final in November, also at Redbridge.
- Testing of new judging products at Levels 1-3 to help support newly qualified judges and give other judges a refresher. Also a review of main deductions and faults booklet.
- Introduction of 'no judge, no comp' and requirement for club with large number of entries to provide two judges made filling judging panels easier.
- In general positive comments about judging increased.
- Lights and acts made for a more spectacular London GfA Final at Redbridge in November 2018.

Concerns

- Lack of volunteers is an on-going concern. A few clubs provided reliable volunteers, but more are needed to ensure the same people aren't having to do all the work at each event.
- The rising number of entries is yet again putting pressure on the length of each competition and the stress on volunteers.
- New electronic ticket system was slow due to connection issues and caused queues, but overall was welcomed and when working got people through quickly.
- Some clubs still not following rules at Southern Grading event around handing gymnasts to parents to allow them to go to medal table as a family.

Looking Forwards:

• GfA elects a new Chair and TC to take forward ideas for coming years.
