### **Annual General Meeting Report 2019**

#### **Highlights for previous year (Since June 2018)**

As used in this document the pronoun "we" refers to the London Rhythmic Gymnastics Technical Committee.

#### **Competitions**

We have successfully organised three London Championships (July 18, December 18 and March 19). We have:

- Produced a thoughtful apparatus allocation per age category aligned with British Gymnastics Events to be used as a platform for further development.
- RG London Championships have included all NDP Levels and Level 0 has been added to younger age categories to bolster participation by recreational gymnasts training 2-4 hours per week.
- Negotiated pricing and secured a new venue, Redbridge, with agreed storage for equipment to host five future competitions (Nov 2019, Feb/Mar/July/Nov 2020). Redbridge has higher ceilings to accommodate the height requirement for Junior and Senior gymnasts.
- Introduced the Disabilities program to London Championship events.
- Agreed to include Group routines in all future events.

#### **British and NDP Qualifications:**

In 2018 the clubs from London Regions have produced:

- 65 qualified gymnasts for NDP Finals (in comparison to 44 in 2018)
  Gymnasts from London Region represent 45% of the total qualified gymnasts for NDP Finals.
- 22 qualified gymnasts for British Championship (in comparison to 16 in 2018).
   Gymnasts from London Region represent 43% of the total qualified gymnasts for British Championship.

#### **Technology**

Further enhancements to the system have been made by our request to accommodate changes introduced by BG (i.e. execution score starting from 20 for lower level gymnasts). We worked in close partnership with a technical solution provider to accommodate and enhance the technology that maintains competition workflow, including score calculation, presentation of the results and various measures to eliminate undesired delays.

#### **Regional Squad and Gymnasts Development**

- Espoir and pre-Espoir Squad has been selected based on the 4<sup>th</sup> London Championship and Regional Grades competition results.
- We successfully organised the first London Squad Training Camp on 26<sup>th</sup>/27<sup>th</sup> May 2019 with extremely positive feedback from all participants. Silviya Miteva (London 2012 Olympic finalist, Brevet II Judge and FIG Level 3 coach) was the Head Coach at the camp. Suzanne Haslam (British Gymnastics Ballet Adviser) was the Ballet Adviser at the camp.

#### **Coaches and Judges Education**

- We continue working with BG representatives and new Venue Managers to assist in organising judging and coaching courses in the region.
- We believe that the planned 2019 -2020 regional squad framework presents a great opportunity to our regional coaches to work with high performance colleagues enhancing the level of coaching in the region.
- We have shared the feedback received from the British Gymnastics Aspire Camp (May 2019) to our regional coaches and fully aligned our objectives with the British Gymnastics national framework.
