Highlights for previous year

- A new committee working together sharing knowledge and advancing our region
- Holding an Open Meeting to share our challenges with clubs and seeking their support for future changes
- A new club for us, Elstree School of Gymnastics, entering our DMT events for the first time
- Our NDP Upskilling Day introduced clubs and coaches to the BG pathway
- Our Judge Upskilling Day for County judges helped to prepare candidates to pass their courses
- Judge courses being held in region for the first time in a few years: TRA County, TRA Regional, DMT Club
- Holding a Regional Team Final training camp for the first time and working closer as a team of coaches/clubs
- Introduction of a Range and Conditioning highly commended award an added motivation for gymnasts
- TC taking responsibility for the event ticketing via Square, PAT testing, background music and new H&S items
- An increase in clubs and coaches attending the BG T&T Symposium than in previous years
- BG supporting and making it easier to run the London Youth Games

Concerns

- Lack of venue to host a combined trampoline and double mini trampoline competition
- Our trampoline venue, Harlington Sports Centre, closing for redevelopment in the upcoming year(s)
- Our DMT venue, Kingston Trampoline Academy, unenthusiastic to host future DMT events
- Too many competition days (14 in 2019 season) for volunteers
- No storage for new equipment purchases region owned DMT set up, BG regulation safety mats
- Clubs not entering as many gymnasts as they would like to due to a lack of judges or suitably qualified judges
- No judge contact database for the TC to use for LG events
- Not enough L3 or higher coaches working in London clubs to build up gymnast to higher levels
- Not enough clubs entering the English Gymnastics or BG Spring Series events

Looking Forwards:

- Finding a new venue big enough for a combined trampoline and double mini trampoline event. Bringing all our competitions streams and clubs back together attending one big competition.
- Finding a storage solution for LG owned equipment between competitions
- Spending the legacy BTF monies on new equipment DMT set up, new trampolines and safety matting
- Newly qualified Club, County, Regional and DMT judges putting their skills into action
- The quality of coaches and gymnastics performance improving. More clubs entering the English and BG Spring Series in 2020. Higher difficulty values being performed by London gymnasts. Higher placing at RTF
- Creating a LG judge/volunteer contact list to help fill unallocated slots at LG events.
- Finding a way to give every gymnast the opportunity to compete at LG events relooking at judge allocation
 per club entry or reducing the number of roles
