Highlights for previous year

- Continued success internationally & nationally for our London gymnasts
- Introduction of the new Women's programme has been received very positively. The spring programme has grown by 20% attracting a few new clubs. The WTC wanted to strive to offer more opportunity to ALL girls and to change the focus away from the concept of only "In Age" being valued.
- Introduction of the execution certificates for individual competition have gone down very well
- Scrutinised the budget and tried to make savings where possible
- Regional trainings organised with Samantha James
- New medal design for recent Teams competition was popular
- On the whole, clubs are working well at competitions helping and encouraging each other. The atmosphere has changed and become very happy and relaxed. Feedback from competitions is positive.

Concerns

- That clubs understand that once judges are submitted for a competition they are available for that competition. Too many judges are then saying they are unavailable. We cannot run competitions without judges. We wish to encourage clubs to get people on judging courses
- Coaches not receiving information via clubs, we have now set up a FaceBook group and encouraged all London coaches and judges to join.
- Coaches placing gymnasts into lower levels than they should be in. We will continue to carefully analyse all competitions for misplaced gymnasts.

Looking Forwards:

- Continued success nationally and internationally
- Training /clinics to encourage NDP and Compulsory Grade participation
- Running a judging /coaching workshop
- Introduce a scoring system which allows judges to input their scores directly
- Continue to evaluate the new programs
- Plan to change medal design approx. every 6 months
