### **Highlights for previous year**

- We welcomed 3 new competitive clubs to our Region.
- Successful competition season on both the Regional and the NDP Pathways.
- The regional events culminated in the 1<sup>st</sup> ever London Region Finals which was a great success.
- The NDP Finals, Exeter were a huge success for London.
- Atmosphere on the competition floor has been supportive amongst clubs.

#### **Concerns**

- Entries have increased with both pathways leading to concerns with accommodating the timetable on the day.
- Lack of higher qualified judges means that it is always the same people who have to Chair or tariff at competitions.
- The only current competition venue is getting too small to accommodate the increases in numbers.

#### **Looking Forwards:**

- NDP entries were successfully completed on BG Online system We now need to review this for regional
  events.
- Keep the whole competition structure under continuous review, particularly regarding "Optional" events such as the Closed/the Open etc.
- Due to crowding and potential structural changes for next season to the NDP programme, we need to consider organisational changes to ensure we can deliver both NDP and Regional programmes well.
