Election of Chairman for Tumbling	 Paul Welch was unanimously voted in as the new chairman of the London Tumbling Technical Committee Paul will now appoint his committee. A treasurer has been found, and coaches from Southwark and Richmond have already agreed to be on the committee. Coaches who were present from Allstarz, Croydon Acro, Sportac, E17 are also keen to be part of the committee and PW will work towards setting this up. Carol Bailey will assist the new treasurer in setting up the tumbling account 	PW & CBa
Judging revalidation	In the next year all judges at each level will have to revalidate. This will include exams. It is hoped that LG funding will be available towards the cost of the courses. Criteria for funding will be set to ensure a judge's previous judging record, within the region, and nationally will be taken into account. Because the revalidation course will be a full course, it will be possible for new candidates to take the course concurrently, or to increase their judge level. The region has lost a number of judges in the past 2 years and clubs should look to encourage and support new judge candidates. It is becoming increasingly difficult to run competitions at acro stars and NDP level with the current number of available judges. The cost of providing out –of –region judges is prohibitive and may jeopardise the current competition structure.	
Priorities for 2016/2017	Acro: CB asked the clubs present to rank their priorities for 2016/2017 and has circulated the results separately. CB & Cba will look to fund the agree clinics and courses.	CB & CBa
Priorities for 2016/2017	<u>Tumbling</u> : PW would like to hold clinics for tumbling and develop it more as a discipline in its own right, with an emphasis on power. Clubs are interested in workshops on Somi Kickouts, and Whips/Somi shapes.	PW

Tumble league	Tumble League will begin again in 2017, with 2 meetings at Bromley and 2 at Sportac. Tumble league will remain in the same format with $\frac{1}{2}$ day Sunday competitions.

LG are also looking to part fund the judge revalidation, so it would seem appropriate for the ATC to concentrate on 1, 2, & 5 in the first instance, with the additional topics included should funds allow.
