AWARD CRITERIA

Below you will find the criteria for the Special Recognition Award. Please take into consideration all the points when making a nomination. The award criteria must have been demonstrated from 1st January – 31st December 2018.

This award is to recognise an individual or team performance achieved in spite of difficulties and obstacles whether they are physical, financial, social or otherwise. The nominees may include persons who fulfil the role of some, or all of the following: coach, participant, administrator, volunteer and/or team.

- 1. All selected gymnasts must be a resident in Northern Ireland and must be a member of a current BG & GNI affiliated Club.
- 2. Must be at least 11 years old by 31st December 2018
- 3. Overcome significant difficulties in the past 12 months to achieve their goals.
- 4. Demonstrated a commitment to gymnastics.
- 5. Developed as a person/team in overcoming their obstacles.

(Please note details of difficulties and/or obstacles will not be released at the awards ceremony at request)

Nominations Forms, accompanied by a supporting statement must be received no later than 5pm, Friday 7th December 2018.

Please note that a photo will be required of the nominee for the presentations. This may be supplied by the nominee themselves on or before Friday 4th January 2019.
